At its meeting of September 19, 2014, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board)

reviewed an affidavit that the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Jaclyn P.

Melillo. On March 11, 2014, Melillo pled guilty to two counts of Sexual Assault-Victim 16-18. Melillo

was sentenced to four years in prison, ordered to forfeit her teaching certificates and subject to Megan's

Law and parole supervision for life. Melillo currently holds a Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility

With Advanced Standing, issued in February 2011 and a Teacher of English certificate, issued in May

2012.

Melillo agreed to relinquish her certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all

attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of September 19, 2014,

the Board voted to accept Melillo's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to

N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-4.8.

Accordingly, on this 19th day of September 2014 it is therefore ORDERED that Jaclyn P.

Melillo's Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and her Teacher of

English certificate be revoked effective immediately.
