THE CERTIFICATES OF : STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS
MAWIYAH BRITTON REED : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Mawiyah Britton Reed as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Reed currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School Certificate of Eligibility, issued in December 2003, a Teacher of the Handicapped certificate, issued in September 2005, a Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in May 2008 and a Teacher of Elementary School With Subject Matter Specialization: Mathematics in Grades 5-8, issued in March 2012. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Reed presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a one year suspension of her certificates. Reed did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of April 14, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 14th day of April 2016, Mawiyah Britton Reed's Teacher of Elementary School Certificate of Eligibility and her Teacher of the Handicapped, Teacher of Elementary School and Teacher of Elementary School With Subject Matter Specialization: Mathematics in Grades 5-8 certificates are hereby SUSPENDED for a period of one year, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Reed return the above-mentioned suspended certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the effective date of the suspension.
