DAVID VAN BUREN : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to David Van Buren as to why his teaching certificate should not be revoked. Van Buren currently holds a Teacher of Instrumental Music certificate, issued in March 1982. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Van Buren presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to he would agree to a six-month suspension of his certificates. Van Buren did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of June 23, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 23rd day of June 2016, David Van Buren's Teacher of Instrumental Music certificate is hereby **SUSPENDED** for a period of six months, effective immediately. It is further **ORDERED** that Van Buren return the above-mentioned suspended certificate to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the effective date of the suspension.
