JOHN J. NEARY : ORDER OF REVOCATION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to John J. Neary as to why his teaching certificate should not be revoked. Neary currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in October 1966. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Neary presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to the relinquishment of his certificate with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-4.8*. Neary did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of March 3, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 3rd day of March 2016, John J. Neary's Teacher of Elementary School certificate is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Neary return the above-mentioned certificate to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
