At its meeting of December 8, 2017, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Union County Prosecutor's Office had forwarded regarding Nataly Lopez. In September 2017, Lopez was found guilty of Endangering the Welfare of a Child. Lopez currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in January 2018.

Lopez agreed to relinquish her credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of December 8, 2017, the Board voted to accept Lopez's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 8th day of December 2017, it is therefore ORDERED that Nataly Lopez's Substitute Credential is hereby revoked, effective immediately.
