DANIEL E. KROPA : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of September 15, 2017, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office had forwarded regarding Daniel E. Kropa. On June 8, 2017, Kropa pled guilty to Endangering-Sexual Conduct with Child by Non-Caretaker. On August 4, 2017, Kropa was sentenced to parole supervision for life, ordered to comply with Megan's Law registration and required to forfeit his teaching certificate. As a result of the conviction, Kropa is disqualified from public school employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:6-7.1 et seq.* Kropa currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in January 2021.

Kropa agreed to relinquish his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of September 15, 2017, the Board voted to accept Kropa's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-4.7*.

Accordingly, on this 15th day of September 2017, it is therefore ORDERED that Daniel E. Kropa's Substitute Credential be revoked, effective immediately.
