SCOTT N. NWATU : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of April 12, 2019, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Camden County Prosecutor's Office had forwarded regarding Scott N. Nwatu. On January 28, 2019, Nwatu pled guilty to Aggravated Assault. On February 22, 2019, Nwatu was sentenced to eight years in prison, followed by three years of parole supervision upon release and ordered to forfeit his teaching certificate. Nwatu currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires on January 2022.

Nwatu agreed to relinquish his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of April 12, 2019, the Board voted to accept Nwatu's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 12th day of April 2019, Scott N. Nwatu's Substitute Credential is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Nwatu return the above-mentioned credential to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
