At its meeting of March 8, 2019, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Camden County Prosecutor's Office had forwarded regarding Deborah A. Tanksley. On September 24, 2018, Tanksley was convicted of Sexual Assault-Victim under 13 years old. Tanksley currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in July 2021.

Tanksley agreed to relinquish her credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of March 8, 2019, the Board voted to accept Tanksley's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 8th day of March 2019, Deborah A. Tanksley's Substitute Credential is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Tanksley return the above-mentioned certificate to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
