ALAN M. ABRAHAM : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of May 17, 2019, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that counsel for Alan M. Abraham had submitted. On September 24, 2018, Abraham pled guilty to Theft By Unlawful Taking. On February 4, 2019, he was sentenced to one year of probation and ordered to pay restitution. He was also ordered to forfeit his public employment and forever disqualified from "holding any office or position of honor, trust or profit under this State or any of its administrative or political subdivisions pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 2C:51-2(d)." Abraham currently holds a Teacher of Music certificate.

Abraham agreed to relinquish his certificate with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of May 17, 2019, the Board voted to accept Abraham's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 17th day of May 2019, Alan M. Abraham's Teacher of Music certificate is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Abraham return the above-mentioned certificate to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
