ELYSE M. CASTILLO : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of March 4, 2022, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office forwarded regarding Elyse M. Castillo. In September 29, 2020, Ms. Castillo pled guilty to Sexual Assault (2nd degree). As a result of the conviction, Castillo is disqualified from public school employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:6-7.1 *et seq.* At the time of conviction, Castillo held a Substitute Credential, which expired January 2021.

Castillo agreed to relinquish¹ her credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of March 4, 2022, the Board voted to accept Castillo's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 4th day of March 2022, it is therefore ORDERED that Elyse M. Castillo's Substitute Credential is hereby revoked, effective immediately.
