AUBREE (GURKOVICH) DEMINISKI: AMENDED ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Aubree (Gurkovich) Deminiski on April 13, 2023, as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Deminiski currently holds a Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, issued January 2014; a Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, issued January 2014; a standard Teacher of English certificate, issued September 2015; and a standard Teacher of Students with Disabilities certificate, issued September 2015.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Deminiski presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a two (2) year suspension of her certificates. Deminiski did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of May 22, 2025, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 22nd day of May 2025, it is therefore ORDERED that Aubree (Gurkovich) Deminiski's Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, standard Teacher of English certificate, and standard Teacher of Students with Disabilities certificate are hereby SUSPENDED for two (2) years, effective July 1, 2025. It is further ORDERED that Deminiski return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
