TODD LEWIS : ORDER ACCEPTING RELINQUISHMENT

At its meeting of August 8, 2025, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit it received from Jennifer Fetterman, Chief Assistant Prosecutor/Special Victims Unit with the Passaic County Prosecutor's Office, regarding Todd Lewis. Lewis currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-8 Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, issued August 2004; and a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-8 standard certificate, issued September 2005.

Lewis agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of August 8, 2025, the Board voted to accept Lewis' relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.10.

Accordingly, on this 8th day of August 2025, it is therefore ORDERED that Todd Lewis' Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-8 Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing and Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-8 standard certificate are hereby ORDERED RELINQUISHED, with the force and effect of a revocation, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Lewis return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
