MARIO MACIAS : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Mario Macias on May 17, 2019, as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Macias currently holds a School Social Worker Certificate, issued May 2000; a Principal Certificate of Eligibility, issued May 2006; a School Counselor Certificate, Issued July 2009; a Supervisor Certificate, issued June 2013; and a Standard Principal Certificate, issued September 2015.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Macias presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to a thirty-day suspension of his certificates. Macias did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of June 25, 2026, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 25th day of June 2026, it is therefore ORDERED that Mario Macias' School Social Worker Certificate, Principal Certificate of Eligibility, School Counselor Certificate, Supervisor Certificate, and Standard Principal Certificate are hereby SUSPENDED for thirty-days, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Macias return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
