JOSEPH S. DAVICSIN : ORDER ACCEPTING RELINQUISHMENT

At its meeting of August 7, 2026, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit it received from Lauren A. Panfile, Assistant Prosecutor with the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office, regarding Joseph S. Davicsin. Davicsin currently holds a Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility, issued March 2004; a Standard Teacher of English certificate, issued May 2017; and a Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility, issued April 2022.

Davicsin agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of April 7, 2026, the Board voted to accept Davicsin's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-4.10*.

Accordingly, on this 7th day of August 2026, it is therefore ORDERED that Joseph S. Davicsin's Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility, Standard Teacher of English certificate and Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility are hereby ORDERED RELINQUISHED, with the force and effect of a revocation, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Davicsin return the above-mentioned paper certificate, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
