We stress, in addition, that there is nothing in the record that would indicate that either of the staff members involved were "in fear of imminent serious bodily injury," N.J.S.A. 2C:12-1, so as to require the Board to conduct a suspension/expulsion hearing under N.J.S.A. 18A:37-2.1 as the result of an assault.
