In November 2006, the State Board of Examiners revoked the county substitute credential of Keith Kaufman (hereinafter "appellant") as a result of information received from the Office of Criminal History Review indicating that the appellant had been convicted of aggravated assault in 2004. On March 6, 2007, the appellant filed the instant appeal to the State Board of Education. By letter dated March 21, 2007, the Deputy Attorney General representing the Board of Examiners requested that the matter be remanded to the Board of Examiners since it had not been aware that the appellant had been admitted into a pre-trial intervention program.

Under the circumstances, we grant the Deputy Attorney General's request and remand this matter to the State Board of Examiners for such further proceedings as are

necessary on an expedited basis to reconsider whether any action is warranted against the appellant's county substitute credential.
