In a decision dated January 15, 2008, the Commissioner of Education denied Appellant's application for a charter. On February 1, 2008, Appellant filed a notice of appeal to the State Board of Education. Appellant was notified on February 21, 2008, that a brief in support of the appeal was due on March 12, 2008. On March 12, 2008, the Attorney General, representing the Commissioner, filed a motion to participate to reply to the points raised on appeal.

On March 17, 2008, Appellant was notified that a brief in support of the appeal had not been received and therefore pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:4-1.12, this matter would be referred to the Legal Committee of the State Board of Education for consideration for failure to perfect the appeal.

As a result of Appellant's failure to file a brief in support of the appeal or to provide any explanation for the failure to file, we hereby dismiss the instant appeal for failure to perfect. <u>See Paszamant v. Board of Education of the Borough of Highland Park</u>, decided by the State Board of Education, April 1, 1992, <u>aff'd</u>, Docket #A-4812-91-3 (App. Div. 1993).
