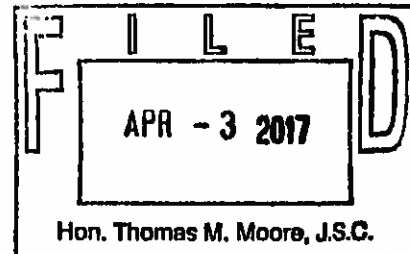



Dunphy, Esq. appearing) seeking an Order vacating the arbitration award entered by Jay David Goldstein on September 25, 2016; and the Court having considered all of the papers submitted by counsel for Plaintiff and for Defendant (John E. Croot, Esq., appearing), and after having heard oral argument on March 13, 2017:

IT IS on this 3<sup>rd</sup> <sup>April</sup> of ~~MARCH~~, 2017, **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1) Plaintiff's motion to vacate the Arbitration Award and Decision In the Matter of the Proceeding between Tenured Teacher Lynderia Mansfield and the State Operated School District of the City of Newark, Essex County, Agency Dkt. No.: 64-2/16 is hereby **DENIED**;
