



Migrant Student Information Exchange (MSIX) Counselor/Registrar **Fact Sheet**



If you are a Counselor/Registrar, MSIX allows you to:

- Obtain a student's full legal name, birth date, and parents' names.
- View a student's enrollment and course history information to help you:
 - o Place a student in the correct courses (either the continuation of a course in progress or the next course in a logical sequence).
 - Determine what credits a student needs for graduation.
 - Determine a student's most recent grade placement.
 - View a student's assessment history to determine additional assessment needs.



Mona is 19 and is enrolling in her third school of the year. She hopes to graduate from high school in a few months.

Neither Mona nor her parents have copies of her earlier transcripts showing what high school credits she has accrued.







The guidance counselor determines that if Mona finishes the current semester with passing grades, she will have enough credits to graduate.



Mona's guidance counselor at the new school has been granted an MSIX account by the state MEP and accesses MSIX. Mona's consolidated record contains all her prior coursework and grades.










If you are a Counselor/Registrar, MSIX allows you to:

- Send a Data Request to solicit course history and state assessment information.
- Find MSIX student records that indicate immunization records exist.
- View a student's consolidated record to determine if there is data that will clarify or explain any confusing information obtained during an interview.
- View a student's MSIX consolidated student record to determine special needs or circumstances such as medical alerts and Priority for Services (PFS) status.



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
