Water Testing at Marie Katzenbach School for the Deaf for 2023 was done by Pace Analytical Services.

Here is a summary of the results from currently occupied areas: These samples are "first draw" samples, which means the water has been immobile for at least six hours in the plumbing.

1st draw Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs): Lead = 15 mg/L

These failures may be due to a number of situations. Corrosion of plumbing and fixtures are the main culprits. Most times the problems can be rectified by replacing the faucets at the problem location.
