Commissioner Librera Participates in Launch of Just for the Kids—New Jersey

Commissioner of Education William L. Librera today helped Governor James E. McGreevey, New Jersey's business leaders and representatives of the state's education community launch a new school improvement program called *Just for the Kids – New Jersey*.

The program features a Web site that allows visitors to compare their schools' academic performance against successful models. The site will also enable education leaders to tap into practices that have effectively enhanced student achievement.
