Advisory: Proposed Readoption with Amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:17, Education for Homeless Children and Students in State Facilities

Trenton, NJ – At its Sept. 8, 2021, public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemaking for publication in the Oct. 18, 2021, *New Jersey Register*:

- Readoption with amendments *N.J.A.C. 6A:17, Education for Homeless Children and Students in State Facilities*, which sets forth rules to ensure homeless children and students placed in State facilities are provided a thorough and efficient education.
