## **Advisory: Proposed Readoption of N.J.A.C. 6A:16, Programs to Support Student Development**

**TRENTON, NJ** – At its January 6, 2021, public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemaking for publication in the February 16, 2021, *New Jersey Register*:

- Readoption with amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:16, Programs to Support Student Development, which sets forth the minimum standards for district boards of education to establish policies and procedures and to operate programs to support the social, emotional, and physical development of students.

Public testimony on the notice is tentatively scheduled to be held on Wednesday, March 3, 2021.
