## **Advisory: Proposed Amendments and New Rules at N.J.A.C. 6A:9B, State Board of Examiners and Certification**

**Trenton, NJ** – At its Feb. 2, 2021, public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemaking for publication in the March 7, 2022, *New Jersey Register*:

Amendments and new rules at *N.J.A.C. 6A:9B*, State Board of Examiners and Certification. The proposed amendments and new rules will implement the limited certificate of eligibility (CE) and limited certificate of eligibility with advanced standing (CEAS) pilot program.
