Advisory: Proposed Readoption with Amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:22, **Student Residency**

Trenton, NJ – At its Feb. 7, 2024, public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemaking for publication in the March 18, 2024, New Jersey Register:

Readoption with amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:22, Student Residency, which sets forth rules to establish procedures for school districts to determine students' eligibility to attend school in a particular school district free of charge based on domicile, residency, or "affidavit student" status.

The notice can be viewed at the New Jersey Department of Education's Administrative Code and Statute webpage.

Public testimony on the rulemaking is scheduled to be held on April 3, 2024. Members of the public may send in written comments concerning the notice by May 17, 2024, via the Department's Administrative Code and Statute webpage or via the mailing or email address contained in the notice.
