Advisory: Proposed Amendments to N.J.A.C. 6A:32, School District Operations

Trenton, NJ – At its Feb. 5, 2025, public meeting, the New Jersey State Board of Education (State Board) approved the following rulemaking for publication in the March 3, 2025, New Jersey Register.

Proposed amendments to N.J.A.C. 6A:32, School District Operations, which sets forth rules related to the daily operation of public schools and school districts. The proposed amendments will align the chapter with P.L. 2023, c. 274, which allows public school students in grades six through 12 to have one State-excused absence each school year for the purpose of attending a civic event.

The notice can be viewed at the New Jersey Department of Education's Administrative Code and Statute webpage.

The State Board values public input in all matters regarding code promulgation. Public testimony on the proposed amendments is scheduled to be held on April 2, 2025. Registration for public testimony will open on March 13, 2025, and close at noon on March 27, 2025.

Members of the public may send in written comments concerning the notices by May 2, 2025, via the Department's Administrative Code and Statute webpage or via the mailing or email address contained in the notice.
