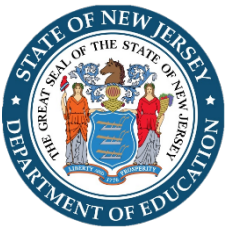

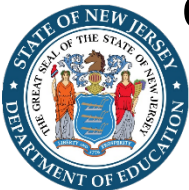

- **identified** with the Department as an outward facing, customer service-oriented organization.

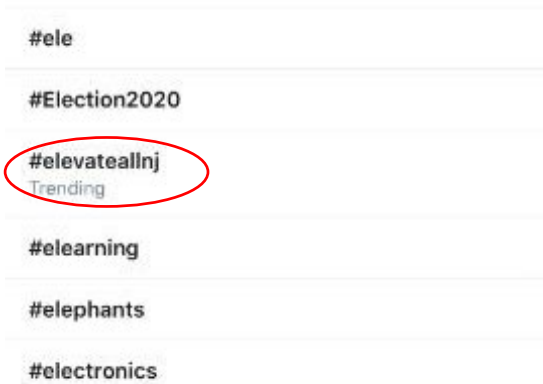


Statewide Conference by the Numbers

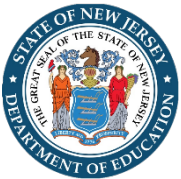
