Subject: Resolution to Adopt the Calendar of State Board Meetings - July 2020 - June

2021--Revised

Attached is the draft resolution of meeting dates which lists the public meeting dates and public testimony sessions scheduled for July 2020 through June 2021. The resolution will be presented for adoption at the June 3, 2020 public meeting.

As you may recall, the former draft resolution considered the inclusion of three work sessions on and moving Open Topic Public Testimony to the third Wednesday of the months of September, January and May. After consideration by the Ad Hoc Committee, the committee recommended that no changes to the schedule be made at this time until the State Board returns to its typical schedule following the end of the Coronavirus Pandemic. Therefore, the current schedule for Open Topic will remain.

Due to past experiences with weather cancellations, four alternative dates have been added during the winter months to accommodate any need to cancel, see December**, January**, February** and March**.

The State Board Office considered the following to determine which Wednesday of each month is most suitable for meetings and for the three work sessions/open topic testimony:

Resolution Annual Calendar Of State Board Meeting/Public Testimony Dates

Whereas, N.J.S.A. 18A:4-7 states that, the State Board of Education shall hold public meetings at least once each month at such times as its rules may prescribe and at such other times and such places within the state as in its judgment may be necessary, but no meeting may commence later than 8:00 p.m.; and

Whereas, N.J.A.C. 6A:1-2.2 requires that such meetings be held at such time, place, and on such dates as established by the State Board, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., Open Public Meetings Act, and notice of such meetings shall be made in a manner consistent with the law; now therefore be it

Resolved, that the State Board establishes the following dates for its monthly business meetings and public testimony sessions for the 2020-2021 school year and directs that a copy of the dates be sent to the Governor, the Secretary of State, the news media, the executive county superintendents, and the State Board agenda subscribers.
