Subject:	Certification of School Districts

Pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC), N.J.S.A. 18A:7A-14 and N.J.A.C. 6A:30, the executive county superintendents have conducted thirty five NJQSAC reviews since the July State Board meeting. <u>Appendix A</u> lists the districts and their most recent NJQSAC scores.

## High Performing Districts Recommended to the State Board for Certification

Thirty-five districts have scored 80 percent or above in all five NJQSAC areas. Therefore, I am recommending that you approve these school districts for certification for a period of three years, pursuant to the date of the issued NJQSAC placement letter.

## Districts Below 80% in One or More NJQSAC Areas

There were no school districts that scored below 80 percent in one or more areas of NJQSAC.
