

## **Preschool Education - Professional Development**



#### **Administrator Seminar:**

- Bimonthly meetings with the early childhood contact from school districts
- Four regional meetings per topic/session

### **Preschool Instructional Coaches (PIC) Seminar:**

- New PIC are provided 3 cohorts with 22 participants in each group
- Sessions are held from October-June with a total of 11 meetings
- Veteran PICs attend 3 meetings over the course of the year- which are topic specific (literacy, math, reflective coaching)



# Preschool Education - Professional Development (slide 2 of 2)

## **Community Parent Involvement Specialist Workshop Series:**

- Each series has three meeting dates/topics which focus on:
  - Roles and responsibility;
  - The development of early childhood advisory councils; and,
  - Family engagement.
- 25 participants per session



# Preschool Education - current and future focus

#### **Current Focus:**

- Preparation of fiscal year 2024 Notice of Opportunity for preschool expansion
- Review of New Jersey Preschool Teaching and Learning Standards
- Department visits to districts offering preschool

#### **Future Focus:**

- 2022-2023 Self Assessment Validations System (SAVS) reviews
- Additional professional development sessions designed for nurses serving preschool and fiscal specialists
