Purpose of N.J.A.C. 6A:22

- The rules establish procedures for districts to determine students' eligibility to attend a particular school district free of charge based on the student's residency.
- The rules establish the process for charging tuition for students who are ineligible for free attendance.
- The rules include exceptions for nonresident students to attend a school district free of charge under limited circumstances.
- These rules apply only to parent-paid tuition; they do not apply to tuition charges between school districts.



Based on the comments received, the Department is proposing an additional amendment at Proposal Level.

- Propose a new rule at N.J.A.C. 6A:22-3.2(i) to include the exception that allows children of teachers in the school district to attend for free.
 - (i) A district board of education may allow, by contract or district board of education policy, nonresident children of teaching staff members to enroll in the school district without the payment of tuition, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:38-3.c.
