Technical Update: I&P Indicators 1 – 7

The Department proposes to amend I&P Indicators 1 through 7 to replace "subgroup(s)" with "student group(s)" to align to the terminology used in the New Jersey School Performance Reports as illustrated below. The Department aims to shift to student-centered language to the extent possible in the rule making process.

Instruction and Program Indicators

The school district is comprised of any composition of:

- 1. The school district's ELA achievement score. The score is comprised of the following:
 - Overall performance: The proficiency rate of all students in a school district;
 - [begin deletion] Subgroup [end deletion] [begin new] Student group[end new] performance: The proficiency rate of all student [begin deletion] subgroups [end deletion] [begin new] student groups [end new];

Technical Update: Governance Indicator 14

The Department proposes to amend Governance Indicator 14 in both Appendices A and B to include the entire requirement at N.J.A.C. 6A:13-2.1(h). The additional language in the indicator will remind school districts of the requirement to employ a certified Student Library Media Specialist (SLMS).

Governance

14. The district board of education ensures that all students have access to library media services that are connected to classroom studies in each school building, including access to computers; school district-approved instructional software; appropriate books, including novels, anthologies, and other reference materials; and supplemental materials that motivate students to read in and out of school and to conduct research. [begin new] Each school district shall provide these library-media services under the direction of a certified school library media specialist. [end new] * (N.J.A.C. 6A:13-2.1(h))







Point values at Appendix A, I&P DPR K-8 School Districts








Point values at Appendix A, I&P DPR 9-12 School Districts






