Background

- > September 22, 2025 Rulemaking Petition Submitted
 - Sought amendments to N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-11.8 to remove the requirement for a candidate to document 20 years of military experience
- October 2025 Policy Review and Alignment Analysis
 - Military science endorsement required for those who teach JROTC in LEAs
 - Requirements include demonstrating 20 years of military experience and holding a valid certification authorizing employment as a military science instructor from the branch of service
 - 20-year requirement was born of alignment to federal limitation that JROTC instructors must be retired
 - 2023/2024 Federal laws expanded JROTC instructor eligibility to include *non-retired* former service members that meet individual branch requirements
- > November 2025 Granted the Petition
 - Included amendment to remove the 20-year service requirement and make additional
 amendments to ensure clarity and alignment with federal certification requirements.

Rationale for Amendments: Federal Alignment

- ➤ 20 years of military service requirement reflected a correlation with military retirement eligibility, which was also reflected in federal JROTC instructor eligibility requirements
- ➤ Both FY2023 and FY2024 National Defense Authorization Act expanded instructor eligibility to non-retired former service members who meet branch-specific instructor eligibility requirements
- ➤ Retaining the New Jersey specific 20-year service requirement creates a stricter barrier to service than the federal requirements across branches
 - Inability to demonstrate 20 years of service has been the sole basis for denial of military science endorsement applications in New Jersey since 2022



Proposed Amendments: N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-11.8

N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-11.8 Military Science

- (a) To be eligible for the standard certificate with a military science endorsement,[the] a candidate shall[:
 - 1. Document 20 years of military service;
 - 2. Hold] hold a current and valid certification [authorizing employment as a military science instructor from] or letter of eligibility issued by the appropriate branch of [service in which the candidate served] the United States Military authorizing the individual to serve as a Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (JROTC) instructor for that branch.
- (b) To retain this endorsement, the holder must maintain the military [employment] authorization at [(a)2] (a) above. The school district shall ensure that the military science teacher maintains **the** valid military [certification] **authorization**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-5.1(b).


