Subject: Special Education Monitoring Report – Jackson Township School District

This correspondence has been sent to inform you of the status of the New Jersey Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs' onsite monitoring regarding the Jackson Township School District's implementation of federal and state special education requirements. All findings of noncompliance identified as a result of monitoring were corrected within one year of identification. No further action regarding this monitoring is required by the district. Of the 46 requirements reviewed, the district demonstrated noncompliance with 33 requirements. Through ongoing verification activities, the district demonstrated correction of all 33 areas of noncompliance. The district must maintain a system of oversight to ensure continued compliance with federal and state special education requirements.
