SUBJECT: Special Education Monitoring - Correction of Noncompliance

This correspondence has been sent to inform you of the results of the New Jersey Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs' monitoring of the Totowa School District's implementation of federal and state special education requirements. Of the 46 federal and state requirements reviewed as part of the process, nine findings of noncompliance were identified. Monitoring activities included review of student outcome data, desk audit, onsite file review and interviews with staff members. I am pleased to inform you that your district demonstrated correction of all findings of noncompliance within one year of identification.

The district is expected to sustain administrative oversight, as well as provide training and technical assistance, on an as-needed basis, to ensure ongoing compliance with IDEA 2004 and positive educational outcomes for students with disabilities.
