Re: Approval of Overnight Travel Waiver for 2026 Annual Conference

Dear Dr. Springer:

The New Jersey Department of Education has reviewed your request submitted on behalf of the Ceceilyn Miller Institute (CMI) seeking a waiver of the in-state overnight travel restriction to support the 2026 Annual Conference in Atlantic City, New Jersey, scheduled for May 19 – 20, 2026.

Under N.J.S.A. 18A:11-12, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.11, and the State Department of Treasury OMB Circular 16-11, reimbursement for in-state overnight travel is generally prohibited. However, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.11(c), exceptions may be granted for events that are broad and multidisciplinary in scope, comprised of content-rich educational programming, and offer important professional development opportunities or required training. After carefully reviewing your submission, **it has been determined that the conference meets these criteria and is hereby approved.**

Waiver Approval Details:

- **Overnight lodging reimbursement** is approved for May 19, 2026, **only**.
- Reimbursement is limited to attendees whose **one-way commute exceeds 50 miles**.
- **Registration fees, mileage, and meals** may be reimbursed per the OMB Circulars 20-04 and 16-11.
- Districts must ensure attendance is limited to staff whose roles align with the conference's purpose or continuing education requirements.

We appreciate CMI's commitment to advancing education and wish you a successful event.
