Re: Approval of Overnight Travel Waiver for 2025 NJ ASBO

Dear Ms. Young:

The New Jersey Department of Education has reviewed your request submitted on behalf of the New Jersey Association of School Business Officials (NJASBO) seeking a waiver of the in-state overnight travel restriction to support the Annual Spring Conference in Atlantic City, New Jersey, scheduled for June 3-5, 2026 and June 9-11, 2027.

Under N.J.S.A. 18A:11-12, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.11 and the State Department of Treasury OMB Circular 16-11, reimbursement for in-state overnight travel is generally prohibited. However, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.11(c), exceptions may be granted for events that are broad and multidisciplinary in scope, comprised of content-rich educational programming, and offer important professional development opportunities or required training. After carefully reviewing your submission, it has been determined that the conference meets these criteria and is hereby approved.

Waiver Approval Details:

- Overnight lodging reimbursement is approved for June 3 and 4, 2026 and June 9 and 10, 2027 only.
- Reimbursement is limited to attendees whose one-way commute exceeds 50 miles.
- Registration fees, mileage and meals may be reimbursed per the OMB Circulars 20-04 and 16-11.
- Districts must ensure attendance is limited to staff whose roles align with the conference's purpose or continuing education requirements.

We appreciate NJASBO's commitment to advancing science education and wish you a successful event.
