- JS collected data re: what PD teachers would like student mental health support, language, general allyship and creating safe spaces inside and outside of the classroom
- ML/immigrants, Sp. Ed., mandate, GSA support (GSA mentorship program?)
- Collecting information from about 70 students (w/ waivers) takeaways: students do not feel safe attending GSA meetings (students not sure what to tell parents about meetings more successful during school than after school)
- Library identified as safest space (!) so, how do we keep that going

- RMSS overlaps calendar of events for LGBTQIA+ statewide for commission to attend and participate in; through intersectional lens - not only in LGBTQ but in bipoc/reproductive healthare/where are spaces we are showing up to o- where can we show up and be of help and connection - looking to hear from students directly - support students directly and should create a network of GSAs - let's put them together?
- Turnover in GSA student participants is an issue from graduating out to vulnerability
- School counselors/BOE members letting them know we are a resource and conversely act as a resource for us as well -
