I was pleased with the overall modeling approach. The good news is the small cost of emission reduction by 2050.

The report is missing the need to meet the IPCC 2018 recommendations to avoid global catastrophe – 45% reduction in emissions by 2030 and 100% carbon free by 2050.

Also missing is an emphasis on reducing Green House Gases other than carbon dioxide (especially methane), in order to head off fast warming from the quicker acting GH Gases.

Natural gas usage is shown declining beginning 2020. This means no new gas infrastructure, and a ban on new gas hookups.

What is missing is implementing the policies, as guided by the modeling.
