This matter arises from allegations that Dr. Allen Masry conducted outside business activities during State time and received compensation time to which he was not entitled.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g)*.
