DECISION

This matter arises from an allegation that Charles Naus, Chief Information Officer, Division of Developmental Disabilities, Department of Human Services, accepted meals, football game tickets and cleaning services from State consultants in return for approving parking passes and paid time off for these consultants.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 19:61-3.1(g).
