DECISION

This matter arises from allegations that Jennifer Fradel, Assistant Attorney General, Office of the Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety, was improperly involved in securing a shadowing opportunity with OAG Human Resources and a full-time position with the Division of Consumer Affairs for her son; that she shared confidential interview questions with her son and that she violated the terms of her recusal by signing off on a background check request form for her son.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission <u>dismissed</u> the matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g).
