This matter arises from an allegation that Lookman Fazal, Chief Information Technology and Digital Officer, New Jersey Transit, was involved in hiring friends and family members in violation of sections 21.2, 23(e)(3) and/or 23(e)(7) of the Conflicts Law, as well as the recusal rule, *N.J.A.C. 19:61-7.4 et seq.*

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g)*.
