DECISION

This matter arises from an allegation that New Jersey Division of State Police Superintendent Colonel Patrick Callahan misused his State position to seek or obtain at home Covid tests for the relatives of a senior government official in violation of sections 23(e)(3) and/or 23(e)(7) of the Conflicts of Interest Law.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 19:61-3.1(g).
