DECISION

This matter arises from an allegation that Lisa Barata, former Deputy Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control violated section 23(e)(7) of the Conflicts of Interest Law (Conflicts Law) by removing confidential State property from her work location upon her retirement from State service.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission <u>dismissed</u> the matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g).
