This matter arises from an allegation that Thomas Jordan violated sections of the Conflicts of Interest Law and/or the Commission's recusal rule by participating in Department of Human Services, Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS) contract negotiations with Rowan SOM or Advanced Database while pursuing employment opportunities with these entities, and becoming involved in a matter on behalf of Advanced Database that he was directly and substantially involved in while employed by DMAHS.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 19:61-3.1(g).
