This matter arises from an allegation that Mary Robinson Potter acted in her official capacity in a matter where she had a financial or personal interest, which were incompatible with the discharge of her duties, in violation of section 23(e)(7) of the Conflicts Law and/or the recusal rule, *N.J.A.C.* 19:61-7.1 et seq., by failing to recuse from the promotional interview of Miriam Rodriguez, with whom she had a previous romantic relationship.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission <u>dismissed</u> the matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g).
