## STATE ETHICS COMMISSION

DECISION

This matter arises from an allegation that Sheila Hoffler acted in her official capacity in two matters where she had a financial or personal interest, which were incompatible with the discharge of her duties, in violation of section 23(e)(7) of the Conflicts Law and/or the recusal rule, *N.J.A.C.* 19:61-7.1 et seq., by failing to recuse from the promotional interviews of Valerie Hartsfield and Mary Robinson Potter, with whom she shared close friendships.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission <u>dismissed</u> the matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g).
