This matter arises from an allegation that William Conroy (“Conroy”), former Deputy Commissioner of Health Systems, New Jersey Department of Health (“DOH”), violated post-employment restrictions by appearing before the DOH on behalf of CarePoint Health Plan within one year of his retirement from State service, and by becoming involved in a matter on behalf of CarePoint that he was directly and substantially involved in while employee at DOH.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g)*.
