**DECISION** 

This matter arises from an allegation that Albert Stabile, D.C. ("Stabile"), a member of the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners ("Board"), Division of Consumer Affairs, Department of Law & Public Safety, sought to use his Board position to influence an independent chiropractic examination to obtain insurance coverage for additional chiropractic treatment for one of his patients.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g).
